1. Dr. C. To consider the request of the Principal, K.R. College of Arts and Science, Kovilpatti to suspend B.Com., B.Sc. Electronics and M.Sc. Electronics and Communication programme for three years from the Academic year 2022-2023 as per University Act and Statutes Chapter XVIII clause (4) together with the office note thereon:

NOTE:

1. Temporary affiliation of the B.Com., B.Sc. Electronics and M.Sc. Electronics and Communication program to K.R. College of Arts and Science, Kovilpatti was granted during the academic year 1997-1998, 1998-1999 and 2007-2008 respectively after the payment of Affiliation & Endowment fee.
2. The Principal, K.R. College of Arts and Science, Kovilpatti vide her letter dated 08.06.2022, requested to close B.Com., B.Sc. Electronics and M.Sc. Electronics and Communication program from the academic year 2022-2023 since there is no students has applied for the above program for last three years and refund the Endowment of Fixed Deposit Receipt.
3. **Tamil Nadu Private Colleges Regulations Act Chapter V, 25 (1)** "No private college and no class and no course of instruction therein in a private college shall be closed without obtaining the prior approval of the **competent authority** and without making such arrangements as may be prescribed for the continuance of the instruction of the students of the private college or the class or the course of instruction, as the case may be, for the period of study for which the students have been admitted".



It is also submitted that **Tamil Nadu Private Colleges Regulations Act Chapter I, 2 Definitions, (3) “Competent authority-in relation to any provision of this act means:**

- i) any University
- ii) authority, officer or person, empowered by the Government, by notification, to be the competent authority”.

4. The Statutes of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Chapter XVIII, 4 reads as follows:

“After three years of inadequate enrolment of students, it shall be open to a college to suspend with prior approval of the Syndicate for a total period not exceeding three academic years, instruction in any subject or course of study in which the college is recognized affiliated or approved. At the end of the period of suspension work may be resumed with the previous approval of the Syndicate. If the work is not resumed at the end of the suspension, the recognition affiliation or approval previously granted shall be regarded as having lapsed, provided that when in any year a college being prepared to make the usual arrangement to give instruction in the subjects in which it has been recognized, affiliated or approved does not, for want or students open classes in one of those subjects, and its reports to the Syndicate before 1st August is shall not be deemed that the college has suspended instruction in that subject, provided also that notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provision, it shall be competent for the Syndicate to consider the need for the continuance of recognition, affiliation or approval of the college in a subject which not being taught for three consecutive years.”

To consider the exoneration of Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant (retired on 31.05.2022) and Tmt. R. Anandakumari, formerly Senior Superintendent (now Assistant Registrar) from the DVAC case No.PE230/2015/EDN/TI, dated 07.11.2016, based on the letter No.PE 230/2015/EDN/T1/, dated 30.03.2022 received from Thiru. K. Shanmugam, the Superintendent of Police, Southern Range, DVAC, No.293, M.K.N. Road, Alandur, Chennai together with office note thereon.

Note:

1. Based on the letter No.3305/H2/2015, dated 08.02.2018 and letter No.3305/H2/2015-2016, dated 29.10.2010 received from Additional Secretary to Government, Higher Education (H2) Department, Chennai and as per the orders of the Vice-Chancellor, a committee has been constituted with the following members to take action on allegations against Tmt.R.Anandakumari, Assistant Registrar and Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant on B.E. Revaluation April 2011.
 1. Dr. A. Suruliandi, Controller of Examinations
 2. Dr. N. Krishnan, Dean of Science
Professor & Head, Centre for Information Technology and Engineering
 3. Dr. C. Thilakam, Dean of Arts, Professor, Department of Commerce
2. The Committee met on 19.12.2018 and submitted the minutes and recommended as follows:
 - (i) As the present circumstances give no option but to take Departmental Action against AO-7 Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant and AO-9 Tmt. R. Anandakumari (now Assistant Registrar, D D & C E Administration) of this University in order to close the file. Hence the Departmental Action Committee recommends to cut one increment without cumulative effect for AO-7 Tmt. Y. Poomathy, (Assistant) M.S. University and AO-9 Tmt. R. Anandakumari (now Assistant Registrar, D D & C E Administration)
3. The minutes of the said committee has been approved by the Vice-Chancellor dated 21.06.2019 and directed to report to the syndicate.
4. Accordingly the one yearly increment has been stopped for both of them as per the recommendations of the Departmental Action Committee with respect to the B.E Revaluation 2011, Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai case.
5. The same has been informed to the Deputy Secretary to Government, Higher Education (A2) Department, Secretariat, Chennai at the Review meeting held on 24.06.2019.



6. The University has taken action against the individuals as per the report and the same has been informed to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government/ Vigilance Commissioner and Commissioner for Administrative Reforms, Chennai vide this office No.MSU/R/Estt/Admn/E1/ DVAC/2019, dated 30.08.2019 and Director, Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Alandur, Chennai vide this office letter No.MSU/R/Estt/Admn/E1/DVAC/2020, dated 02.03.2020.
7. The Syndicate at its meeting held on 17.09.2019 resolved that approval of the above report is deferred. A more details Departmental level enquiry should be initiated.
8. Accordingly, a committee has been constituted with the following members to conduct detailed enquiry and the meeting for the same has been conducted on 17.09.2020 in connection with B.E. Revaluation April 2011 Examinations and submitted a draft letter / memo to be issued to the individuals.

9. The draft letter / memo submitted by the above committee has been approved and the same has been served to Tmt. R. Anandakumari, Assistant Registrar, DD&CE – Administration (formerly Senior Superintendent), Tmt. Y. Poomathy, (Assistant).
10. The explanation submitted by Tmt. R. Anandakumari, Assistant Registrar, DD&CE – Administration (formerly Senior Superintendent) Tmt.Y.Poomathy, (Assistant) in connection with B.E. Revaluation April 2011 Examinations has been placed before the above said committee.
11. Further the committee again met on 17.11.2020, Tmt. R. Anandakumari, Assistant Registrar, DD&CE – Administration (formerly Senior Superintendent) Tmt. Y. Poomathy, (Assistant) have appeared before the enquiry committee and the committee has enquired the individuals and submitted the report.
12. The committee has submitted the report about the detailed enquiry and not sentenced / recommended any penalties.
13. As one of the incumbent Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant retired from the services on 31.05.2022, a letter no.MSU/R/Estt/Admn/E1/DVAC/2022(i), dated 16.03.2022 was sent to the Superintendent of Police, Southern Range, DVAC,

Alandur, Chennai with a copy marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, DVAC, Tirunelveli.

14. In response to the above letter, the Superintendent of Police, Southern Range, DVAC, Alandur, Chennai has informed vide letter No.PE 230/2015/EDN/TI, dated 30.03.2022 that this **“preliminary enquiry was registered against Dr. K.S.P. Durairaj, formerly Controller of Examination, M.S. University, Tirunelveli District and others into the allegations mentioned in the final report dated 07.11.2016. After completion of enquiry, this Directorate final report was sent to the Government through Vigilance Commissioner on 07.11.2016 recommended Departmental action against Tmt. Poomathy, Assistant, M.S. University, Tirunelveli and others.**

Based on the above, the final orders passed against Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant and Tmt. R. Anandakumari formerly Senior Superintendent awarded a punishment of stoppage of yearly increment and transferring them to low profiled sections and hence the decision may be taken at your end”.

15. Accordingly, Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant and Tmt. R. Anandakumari, formerly Senior Superintendent (now Assistant Registrar) have been exonerated from the DVAC case No.PE230/2015/EDN/TI, dated 07.11.2016 and Tmt. Y. Poomathy, Assistant is permitted to retire from the services on 31.05.2022 as they were awarded a punishment of stoppage of one yearly increment and transferred to a low profile sections.

To consider for appropriate direction to sanction of Full pension and other benefits in respect of Dr.P.Govindaraju, (who was placed under Compulsory Retirement as per Syndicate resolution dated 20.12.2018) based on the orders of the Madurai Bench



of Madras Higher Court, Madurai on W.P (MD) No.979 of 2019, Writ appeal (MD) No.428 / 2020 with office note thereon.

Note

Dr. P. Govindaraju, Professor, Department of Communication joined duty on 10.03.2004. As per the Syndicate resolution cited under reference (1), he was placed under Compulsory Retirement on 21.12.2018.

Dr. P. Govindaraju filed WP (MD) No.979 of 2019 before the Hon'ble Madurai bench of Madras High Court, Madurai cited under ref (2) and the court directed the University re-instate his service w.e.f. 21.12.2018 with all attendant benefits, including arrears of salary and pass such further other suitable orders. He also filed a Contempt Petition.

Hence, the matter was referred with Syndicate by circulation. The Syndicate by circulation dated 13.02.2020, has resolved as follows:

RESOLUTION:

"CONSIDERED the judgement of the WP (MD) No. 979 of 2019 filed by Dr. P. Govindaraju, Former Professor, Department of Communication, who was placed under Compulsory Retirement along with legal opinion given by the University Legal Counsel M/s. Ajmal Associates, Attorneys, Madurai and resolved to file an appeal on the judgement in line with the opinion of the University Legal Counsel.

FURTHER RESOLVED that to direct the University Legal Counsel to file an appeal immediately".

In continuation, the University filed a writ Appeal (MD) No.428 / 2020 against the orders of the WP (MD) No.979/2019.

The court ordered in WA (MD) No.428 of 2020 and CMP (MD) No.2959 of 2020 dated 19.03.2020, it is stated that it is also made clear that by allowing the respondent to retire, the appellant does not lose their right to pursue this appeal or to revive the order of punishment to its logical end.

At this Juncture, as per the letter dated 23.06.2020, received from Dr. P. Govindaraju, with regard to permit to join in the University service and retirement in the due date, was also referred with the University Legal Counsel. The legal counsel concluded that the delinquent may be permitted to retire, however withholding all his benefits so as to enable the University to implement the punishment as observed by the High Court in the event of being successful

Hence, Dr. P. Govindaraju, was permitted to join duty on 29.06.2020 and has submitted his joining report. Subsequently, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor dated 30.06.2020 and this office letter dated 30.06.2020 he was relieved from the service of this University on 30.06.2020.



The above matter was reported to Syndicate held on 21.08.2020 and resolved as below:

- (i) **RESOLVED** that the above report is recorded and the action taken is ratified.
- (ii) **FURTHER RESOLVED** that without prejudice of the outcome of Writ Appeal W.A (MD) No. 428/2020 against the orders in WP (MD) No. 979 of 2019 and CMP (MD) No. 2959 of 2020 dated 19.03.2020 of Dr. P. Govindaraju, who was relieved on 30.06.2020 be given 2/3 of the pension as per the Statutes of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University **Chapter XVII, STATUTE – 9 COMPULSORY RETIREMENT Clause I (a) which reads as “when a member has been compulsorily retired from service as a penalty he may be granted by the authority competent to impose such penalty pension or gratuity or both, at a rate not less than 2/3rd of normal pensionary benefits which will be due to him if he retires normally on the date of compulsorily retirements.”**
- (iii) **ALSO RESOLVED** to conduct effectively the case which is pending before the division bench admitted in W.A (MD) No. 428/2020 against the orders in WP. (MD) No. 979 of 2019 and CMP (MD) 2959 of 2020 as per the resolution of the Syndicate circulation dated 13.02.2020.

In accordance with the Syndicate Resolution dated 21.08.2020 and the orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor dated 30.09.2020, 2/3rd of Provisional Pension of Rs.33,270/- is being disbursed to Dr. P. Govindaraju with effect from 01.07.2020.

The University Legal Counsel has advised the University to disburse the amount of salary by deducting the subsistence allowance, which all to be paid to Dr. P. Govindaraju till actual retirement (i.e.30.06.2020) as per the court direction. Further, University Legal Counsel has also requested this office to disburse the payment by way of Demand Draft and to send the Photocopy of the Demand Draft to them, so as to produce in the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.

Accordingly, a total amount of Rs. 49,02,851/- (Rupees forty nine lakhs two thousand eight hundred and fifty one only) was sanctioned and a net amount of Rs. 41,99,052/- was arrived after deducting amount of Rs. 7,03,799/- towards subsistence allowance, NHIS, SPF and FBF etc.

Thus Rs. 41,99,052/- (Rupees forty one lakhs ninety nine thousand and fifty two only) was drawn in favour of Dr. P. Govindaraju, by way of Demand Draft. (Demand Draft No. 770253, DD dated 07.12.2020, Indian Bank, Abishekapatti Branch) and a photocopy of the same was sent to Legal Counsel.

Accordingly, the Demand Draft for a sum of Rupees Rs. 41,99,052/- (Rupees forty one lakhs ninety nine thousand and fifty two only) was handed over to Dr. P. Govindaraju as per this office letter No. MSU/R/ESTT/T/E1/SALARY/2020 dated 10.12.2020.

The above matter was placed before the Syndicate held on 16.07.2021 for ratification and the Syndicate has resolved as follows “RESOLVED that the above reports is recorded and the action taken is ratified”.



At this juncture, the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court delivered orders on 20.04.2022 in respect of WA(MD) No. 428 of 2020 filed by The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University where in it is concluded that the writ appeal stands dismissed. No costs.

In continuation, Dr. P. Govindaraju in his letter dated 20.05.2022 has requested to disburse the full pension and other benefits admissible with interest to him at the earliest.

So far 2/3 pension is being disbursed to him from 01.07.2020 to till date, based on the Syndicate resolution. Hence, sanctioning full pension may be considered by placing the matter before the Syndicate for appropriate direction.

On scrutiny of records, it has been observed that previously Dr. P. Govindaraju rendered service in Anna University, Chennai. In this regard, it is stated that only an amount towards pension contribution has been received by this office and Leave salary contribution is not received till date.

In this connection, as per order of the Vice-Chancellor dated 25.05.2022, a letter has been sent to the Registrar, Anna University, Chennai (vide this office letter No. MSU/R/ESTT/T/E1/LSC/Anna Univ./2022 dated 27.05.2022) and awaiting for reply.

Under this circumstances, full pension can be considered only for the services rendered in Manonmaniam Sundaranar University only until receipt of the relevant contribution amount to be received from Anna University, Chennai.

The matter of sanctioning full pension which includes the services rendered at Anna University may be considered only after receipt of Leave Salary Contribution from Anna University, Chennai.

Further, it is noted that the Syndicate at its meeting held on 21.08.2020 has resolved to conduct effectively the case which is pending before the division bench admitted in W.A (MD) No. 428/2020 against the orders in WP. (MD) No. 979 of 2019 and CMP (MD) 2959 of 2020 as per the resolution of the Syndicate circulation dated 13.02.2020.

Under this circumstances, this matter may be placed before the ensuing Syndicate for further direction since Madurai Bench of Madras High Court dismiss the Writ Appeal WA (MD) No. 428 of 2020 filed by The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University.

RESOLUTION

CONSIDERED AND RESOLVED that the sanction of Full pension and other benefits in respect of Dr.P.Govindaraju, (who was placed under Compulsory Retirement as per Syndicate resolution dated 20.12.2018) based on the orders of the Madurai Bench of Madras Higher Court, Madurai on W.P (MD) No.979 of 2019, Writ appeal (MD) No.428 / 2020 be made only after the receipt of Leave salary contribution from Anna University Chennai.

Note:

1. As per the provisions laid down in UGC Regulations 2018 and subsequent G.O.(Ms) No.5, Higher Education (H1) Department dated 11.01.2021, a screening cum Evaluation Committee and Selection Committee have been duly constituted. Further the Committee has interacted / interviewed those Faculty Members and submitted the recommendations.
2. The recommendations of the Screening cum Evaluation Committee and Selection have been placed before the Finance Committee at its meeting held on 11.02.2022. The Finance Committee dated 11.02.2022 has resolved the following resolution :

“Resolved that the incumbents without LF audit objections be given CAS promotions from their qualifying date by notionally and monetary benefit with effect from the date of approval of Syndicate.

Further resolved that the CAS promotions of incumbents with audit objections be placed before the next Finance Committee for appropriate direction”

The above minutes of the Finance Committee have been approved by the Syndicate dated 14.02.2022.

4. It is noted that, The G.O (MS) No: 145, Higher Education (H1) Department, dated 06.07.2018 reads as follows regarding pay fixation under the caption promotion.

(N) Promotion

“When an individual gets a promotion, his new pay on promotion would be fixed in the Pay Matrix as follows:

On promotion, he would be given a notional increment in his existing Academic Level of Pay, by moving him to the next higher cell at that level. The pay shown in this cell would now be located in the new Academic level corresponding to the post to which he has been promoted. If a cell identical with that pay is available in the new level, that cell shall be the new pay; otherwise the next higher cell in that level shall be the new pay of the employee. If the pay arrived at in this manner is less than the first cell in the new level, then the pay shall be fixed at the first cell of that level.”

Mahaboob Athiff, Attorney at Law has been one of the leading Advocates in the said M/s.Ajmal Associates, Madurai who has dealt so many cases related to all service matters, affiliation matters, issues related to qualification approval for the affiliated college teachers, GST cases, Exam related matters, DD & CE (others state) Centres Jurisdiction issues of this University and 90% of the cases has been won on University side and defend the cases effectively and efficiently. In some of the cases, the Hon'be High Court has appreciated Mr. M. Mahaboob Athif for his valuable arguments. Moreover he is well acquainted with the Act and Statutes of this University and Government G.Os and in many of the legal issues his service in the form of legal opinion and other ways have been commendable.
- 2) Now, Mr.M. Mahaboob Athiff, Attorney at Law has informed that he had the benefit of working under 3 Vice Chancellors and in view of administrative reason he has no longer remain as a part of M/s. Ajmal Associates, Attorneys', Madurai and he has started his individual practice and he might not be able to represent the University any further. He has requested to consider his candidature for appointment of an additional standing Counsel of the University in the light of the following:
- 3) He has also informed that he had a professional experience of 13 years as an advocate and has practiced in the Madras High Court, its Bench at Madurai and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and he has represented the University in all its litigations since 2012 in the Madurai Bench and the Madras High Court for the past 10 years. He has further informed that he is presently the standing counsel of various other statutory bodies and public sector undertaking such as the Tamil Nadu Housing Board, Hindustan Petroleum Corporation & the Employees Provident Fund Organization. He has represented for various other statutory bodies in the past as standing counsel on behalf of M/s. Ajmal Associates such as Gas Authority of India Ltd., Tamil Nadu Waqf Board, Tamil Nadu Ex Servicemen Corpn., Bar Council of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry, The National Human Rights Commission.
- 4) In the light of the above, he has requested to appoint him as Additional Standing Counsel for the University for the litigations in Hon'ble High Court of Madras, Chennai and the Hon'ble High Court of Madurai Bench.
- 5) In this connection, it is also submitted that **The Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Statute, Chapter XX reads as follows:**

2. The Community Radio is a contextualised media initiative for the adjoining communities to disseminate and express their cultural and social needs.



The community Radio intended to be set up in the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University will cater to the nearby communities around the university campus within the radius of 15 Kms. The radio transmitter used would be 50-watt capacity. It is to be noted that the WPC of the Department of Telecommunication has allotted 90.4 MHz in FM Mode for the Community Radio station in Manonmaniam Sundaranar University.

3. Community Radio is one of the most cost-effective media used in communication and broadcast of information to people and communities. Timely and context specific delivery of messages and information is the crux of the Community Radio Medium. Community radio is a type of radio service that offers a model of radio broadcasting beyond commercial and public service. Community radio broadcasting serves geographic communities and communities' interest especially the rural masses. The area of thrust for the Community Radio initiative will be focusing on education, health and community development which will invariably address to all the people of the Community.
4. In this regard, it is now sought by the Department of Information and Broadcast that the name of the Community Radio Station be finalised and communicated. The Call Sign designated to the Radio that will be communicated to the audience for listening and participating. The name of the Community Radio is proposed as "MANO COMMUNITY RADIO" as recommended in the Department Faculty meeting held on 13.07.2022 at 11.00 a.m and the same has been approved by the Vice-Chancellor for placing before the Syndicate for consideration and approval.

2. The Government has decided to adopt the decision of the Government of India for State Government employees, teachers and pensioners / Family pensioners for freezing the Dearness Allowances at current rates till July 2021 in view of crisis arising out of COVID – 19.
3. The Government of India has enhanced the Dearness Allowance payable to its employees from the existing rate of 17% to 28% and 28% to 31% respectively with effect from 1st July 2021.
4. Hon'ble Chief Minister has made announcement under Rule 110 of the Legislative Assembly that Dearness Allowance shall be given to the State Government Employees with effect from 01.01.2022
5. The enhanced rate of Dearness Allowance payable under these orders shall be paid in cash with effect from 01-01-2022. Dearness Allowance for the period from 01-01-2020 to 31-12-2021 shall be paid at the rates of 17% continuously.
6. The Government also direct that the revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned above shall be admissible to full time employees who are at present getting Dearness Allowance and paid from contingencies at fixed monthly rates. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order shall not be admissible to part time employees.
7. a. The revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order shall also apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff working in aided educational institutions, employees under local bodies, employees governed by the University Grants Commission / All India Council for Technical Education scales of pay, the Teachers / Physical Education Directors / Librarians in Government and Aided polytechnics and Special Diploma Institutions, Village Assistants in Revenue Department, Noon Meal Organisers, Child Welfare Organisers, Anganwadi workers, Cooks, Helpers,

Panchayat Secretaries / Clerks in village Panchayat under Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department and other employees drawing pay in the prescribed Level of Pay in the Pay Matrix.

b. This order will apply to the following categories of Pensioners:

- (i) Government Pensioners, Teacher Pensioners of aided and Local Body educational institutions and other Pensioners of Local Bodies.
- (ii) The State Government employees who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertaking / Autonomous Body / Local Body / Co-operative institution and have become entitled to restoration of commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount.
- (iii) Present and future family pensioners: In the case of divisible family Pensioners, Dearness Allowance shall be divided proportionately.
- (iv) Former Travancore – Cochin State Pensioners drawing their pension on 1st November, 1956 in the Treasuries situated in the Treasuries situated in the areas transferred to Tamil Nadu state on that date, i.e. Kanyakumari District and Shenkottai Taluk in Tenkasi District.
