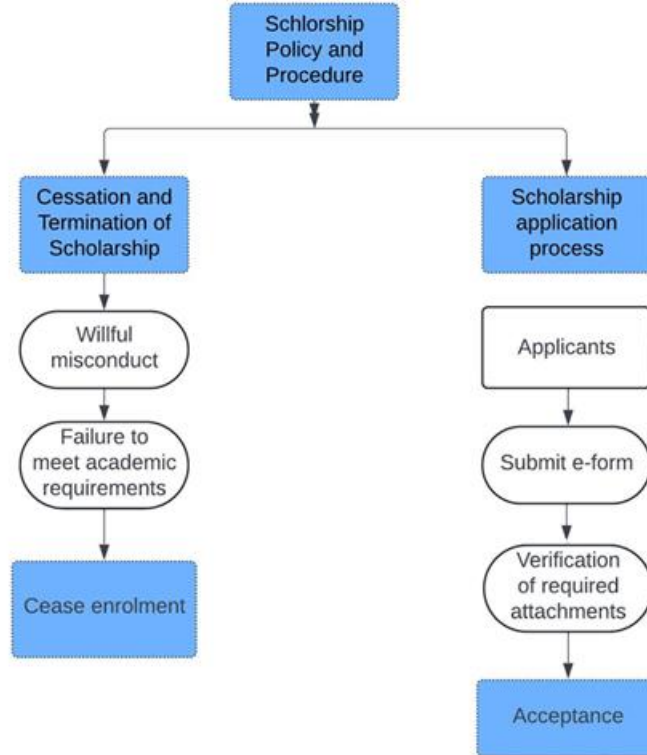
Scholarship or Student welfare committee Formation

The Scholarship Committee is formed by the Scott Christian College administration comprising of representatives from the departments. The tenure of the committee starts from the date of appointment up to the end of the concern academic year or up to the constitution of next committee.

Objectives

- To confirm that no student discontinues his/her studies due to financial reasons
- To disseminate the information regarding the government and management specific scholarship schemes
- To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families for pursuing higher studies.
- To motivate students to excel well in studies by giving financial back support

POLICY AND SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE



GUIDELINES

- The applications should be accompanied by a statement by the parent or the guardian
- Students of backward class or scheduled caste must submit a certificate from the revenue officer, not below the rank of the Deputy Thashildar
- The college is not responsible for the grant and non-grant of government scholarships
- Grant of government scholarships is admissible to the students only when the sanction order for online payment of scholarship is issued by the appropriate authorities
- No student is allowed to hold more than one scholarship at a time, irrespective of type and amount of scholarship and/or study support donations, subjected to rule 92 Tamil Nadu Educational Rules (TNER) and rules of Government of India.
- The scholarship money will be disbursed to the student's bank account number after verification of all necessary documents. The student has to sign the relevant documents before receiving the money

- Students in need who do not receive any scholarships are provided with the management scholarships and financial help from the student welfare fund

Government of India Scholarships

- An adhoc merit scholarship is awarded to SC/ST students of Hindu and Christian converts who have secured more than 60% marks in their Higher secondary examination in the first attempt.
- National scholarship is awarded to children of primary and secondary grade school teachers who secure more than 60% marks in the higher secondary examination. The scholarship will be provided on a meritorious basis because only 60 students from a state is eligible to receive the scholarship.
- National loan scholarship is awarded to students who have scored more than 60% marks in their higher secondary examination and parents annual income does not exceed Rs. 8,00,000.

- ✓ The value of the scholarship is Rs.12,000 for UG courses and and Rs.20,000 for PG courses
- ✓ The payment of EMI by the student starts once the student has begun to earn or three years after the completion of the course whichever is earlier
- Scholarships are awarded to children of freedom fighters and political sufferers who have undergone more than six months imprisonment.
- Dependents of the ex-servicemen can apply through the L.S.B.A. board
- Students of the Part I Hindi should apply for scholarship to the government through the Principal duly forwarded by the Head of the department of Hindi before the month of July every year
- Single girl child enrolled in the departments are eligible for PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship by UGC
- NET Qualified research scholars are eligible to receive monthly fellowships from funding agencies such as UGC/CSIR

Government of Tamil Nadu Scholarships

- Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Higher Education Assurance Scheme is awarded to encourage the enrolment of girls from Government schools in higher education institutions.
- Each student of B.A. History (tamil medium) will get an incentive of Rs. 900
- Adi Dravidar welfare department awards scholarship is beneficial to scheduled caste and scheduled tribe students including converts whose parents annual income do not exceed Rs. 2,50,000.
- Department of backward class awards scholarships to all BC and MBC students whose parents income do not exceed Rs, 2,00,000
- Differently abled students including physically challenged and blind are eligible for tuition fee concession
- Children of farmers are eligible for Uzhavar Scholarship
- Tuition Fee exemption for all UG Government Aided Programmes

Management Scholarship

The management of the Scott Christian College aids the needful students financially if they do not receive any other government scholarships. Tuition fee exemption is given to undergraduate students of aided department and Self-financing departments. Students who achieve in sports are given 25 percent tuition fee exemption, provided they win sports

at the university level or higher. SC-ST cell and OBC cell of the college monitors over the financial aid rendered to SC-ST and OBC students.

Economically backward students who do not receive any other scholarships are supported financially by individuals, philanthropists through any of the following schemes

- Scholarship to children of church workers
- Scholarship to the children of non-teaching staff
- Endowment scholarships and awards
- Midday meals scheme
- Scholarship through student welfare fund
- Individual support / other than parents
