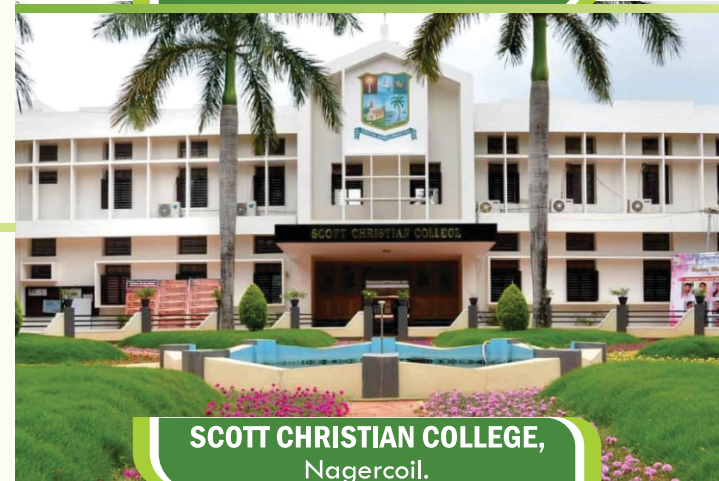

About the College

A village-church school founded by Rev. W.T. Ringeltaube at Mylaudy in 1809, one of the London Missionary Society missionaries, was shifted to Nagercoil in 1818 by Rev. C. Mead and elevated to Scott Christian College in 1893 by the inexorable efforts of Rev. Dr. J. Duthie who became its first Principal. During 1908 - 1910, Rev. George Parker built the science block with a legacy of £ 1000 from the family of Mr. Septimus Scott and a grant from the Government of Travancore. Mr. G.H. Marsden, M.A. Tripos of the University of Cambridge, took charge as Principal on February 1, 1927 and continued till 1957 with whom the legacy of the English Principals ceased. Mr. B. Arumai Raj was the first Indian to take over as the Principal in 1957 who continued till 1966 and was succeeded by Dr. John D.K. Sundersingh till 1975. During Dr. Sundersingh's tenure, the college was shifted to the present campus due to want of space and currently it stands high above the rest of the institutions around, ranked 27th in India and 7th in Tamil Nadu offering 16 Undergraduate Courses, 14 Postgraduate Courses, 10 M.Phil. Programmes and 11 Doctoral Programmes (all recognized as Research Centres). Today, the College has completed 128 years of educational service to people in and around the district.

Places of interest in and around the venue

The venue of the Conference is Scott Christian College at Nagercoil. Nagercoil derives its name from the historic Nagaraja Temple situated in the heart of the town. Kannyakumari popularly known as the 'Cape Comorin', is situated at the southern tip of the Peninsula where the three seas namely, the Bay of Bengal, the Arabian sea and the Indian Ocean meet and hence frequently referred to as the

Tri-sea junction. Other places of interests include the Padmanabhapuram Palace, Udhayagiri Fort, Circular Fort, Thirparappu Cascade, Asia's longest flume at Mathoor, Mandaikad Temple, St. Thomas' unfinished Church (Arapally) at Thiruvithancode etc. The venue is situated along the National Highway NH 47 and is well-linked by rail and road. The nearest airport is Thiruvananthapuram located approximately 70 km away from the venue. Nagercoil enjoys a warm and humid weather with intermittent showers in January and February.

Objectives of the Conference

- 1) To bring all enthusiastic researchers under a common ceiling
- 2) To make researchers aware of the increasing importance of interdisciplinary approach
- 3) To help researchers interact thereby updating their knowledge
- 4) To offer a common platform for budding researchers to unmask their findings
