





SCC and GIK therefore agree to conduct programs for academic excellence in the

areas of mutual interestin accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

The University of Madras' Department of South Indian Music recognizes the course, together with an undergraduate degree in any subject, a passing grade in the GIK, Chennai Diploma in Music qualifies a student for admission to the M. A. Degree Course (choice-based credit system) offered by the University of Madras' School of Fine and Performing Arts, Department of Indian Music, starting from the academic year 2018–19.

OBJECTIVES:

To teach all forms of Carnatic music like geethams, varnam and andkeerthanai completely in Tamil language

To sensitize the students as to the real origin of Carnatic music

To teach the students of the real history of Carnatic music

To teach the students scientifically correct fundamental theories of Carnatic music

To train the students to become full-fledged Kacceri performers

To prepare the students for acareer in Carnatic music especially teaching Karnatic.

To sensitize the students of the prevalent differences in the theory and performance of Carnatic music and to train the students for further research

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. To commence the course in SCC, with a minimum of 30 students.
- The Principal of SCCwill coordinate the course and will be an ex officio member of the Committee
- 3. The course shall be offered in four to six semesters in SCC, with aworkload of 200 hours in total with 175 practical classes and 25 hours of theory
- 4. The syllabus and the complete texts with notations will be given by GIK
- The copyrights solely belong to theGIK
- Teachers shall be appointed by SCC
- 7. The teacher must have a Master's degree in music or with a bachelor's degree in any subject and trained in vocal Carnatic by a notable music master
- 8. The teacher's fee is to be decided by SCC
- 10. Every class must have not more than 50 students
- 11. The tuition fee is to be decided by SCC (about Rs. 1000).
- 12. Thirty percent of the tuition fee is to be sent to GIK
- 13.Examinations will be conducted by GIK
- 14. An examination fee of Rs 1000 /per student shall be sent to GIK

- 15. Certificates shall be issued jointly by SCCand GIK.
- 16. SCC and GIK further agree that the above-mentioned stipulations are agreed upon and thereby the course will be conducted.
